Spring 2025

School Visit

The Sustainability Club at Khalifa University organized an educational outreach session designed for 2nd-grade students at International Community Schools Mushrif Campus. The visit focused on introducing young learners to the concepts of sustainability in an engaging and interactive way.

Location: The event took place at International Community Schools, Mushrif Campus.

Activities: The session began with a PowerPoint presentation introducing the idea of sustainability and explaining why it is important. Afterward, students took part in a series of fun and hands-on activities, including:

- Drawing their own sustainable superhero to imagine how they can help the planet.
- Completing a turtle painting using recyclable materials to learn about reuse in a creative way.
- Matching trash to the correct recycling bin to build practical recycling skills.
- Becoming sustainability detectives, exploring how to spot good environmental practices.

At the end of the session, students received giveaways as a reminder of what they learned and to encourage them to practice sustainability every day.

Purpose: The event aimed to raise awareness about sustainability among young students, spark their curiosity about protecting the environment, and empower them with ideas and skills to make positive changes in their daily routines. It also served as an opportunity to represent the Sustainability Club outside the university and strengthen connections with the community.



Spring 2025 Team Building Workshop

To start the Spring 2025 semester, the Sustainability Club held a team-building workshop focused on reflecting on the progress and activities accomplished during Fall 2024. Members shared ideas and discussed upcoming plans and events for the new semester.

The gathering featured warm karak and other refreshments, while the President and Vice President handed out small giveaways like pins as tokens of appreciation. An ice breaker game was done where photos of countries visited over the winter break were shown, and everyone guessed which member had traveled there. Other team competitions and activities were also played to help strengthen connections among members.

Many students appreciated the thoughtful gesture, and international students especially liked that the message was written in English, which helped them understand the purpose and cultural significance. 1. **Event:** The Sustainability Club organized Sustainable Day, a comprehensive event designed to promote awareness about climate action and sustainable living through interactive activities and educational discussions.

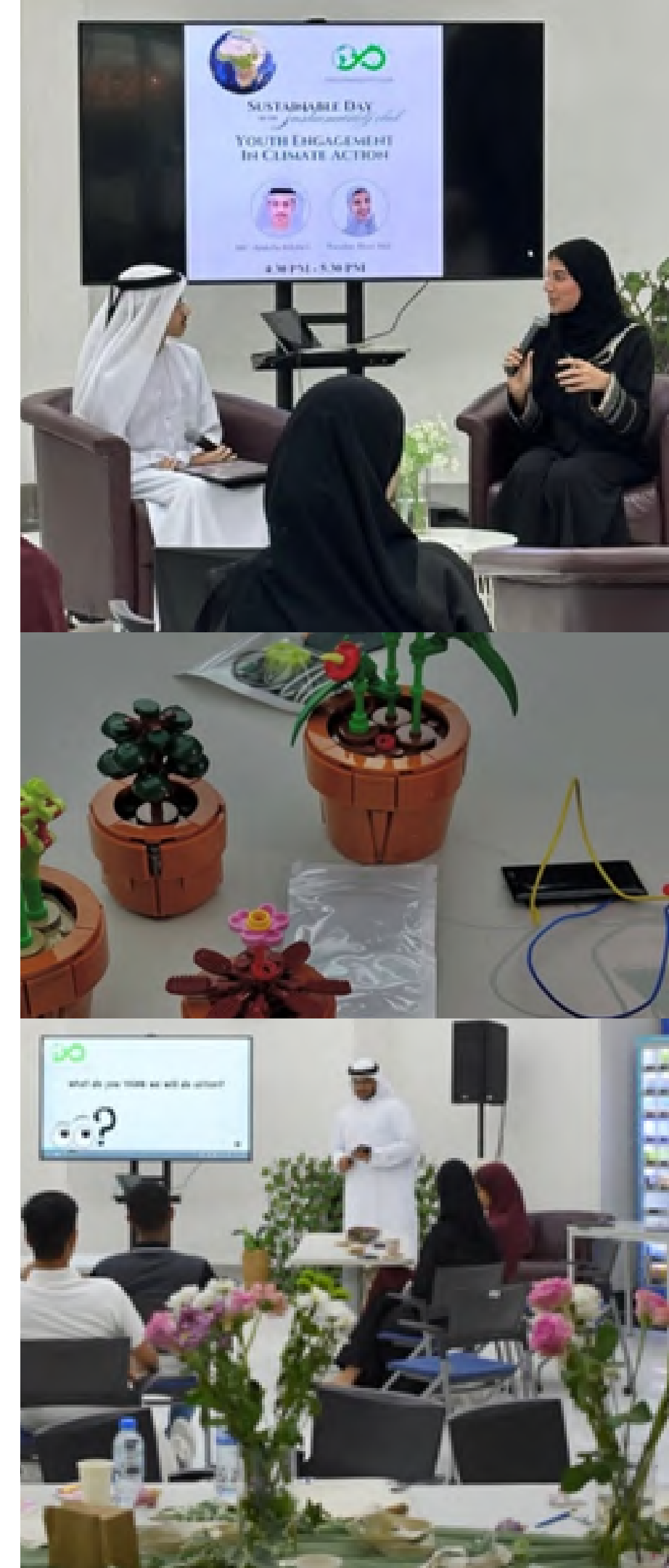
2. **Location:** The event was held at the Main Campus, Building E, Student Hub, Ground Floor

3. **Activities:** The program featured a variety of activities, including:

- A panel discussion on Youth Engagement in Climate Action with speakers sharing insights about environmental activism and the role of young people in driving change.
- A hands-on workshop on Renewable Energy and Sustainability, where participants learned about solar panels and even created their own as part of the session.
- Kahoot games that tested students' knowledge about sustainability and climate topics.
- A wall where attendees could write notes and pledges on how they plan to be more sustainable in their daily lives.
- A station for building LEGO plants, combining creativity and environmental themes.
- Creative stations where students could: make clay planet creations, create cotton planet art, and decorate tote bags and shells in the Tote/Shell Design Station.
- Additional activities and displays on recycled materials and sustainable practices.

Students who attended the panel discussion received 1 CS hour as recognition for their participation.

4. **Purpose:** The event aimed to educate students about the importance of sustainability, inspire them to adopt environmentally responsible habits, and empower them to take part in climate action initiatives. It also provided a space to explore creativity, connect with others, and engage directly with influential speakers and community leaders working toward a more sustainable future.

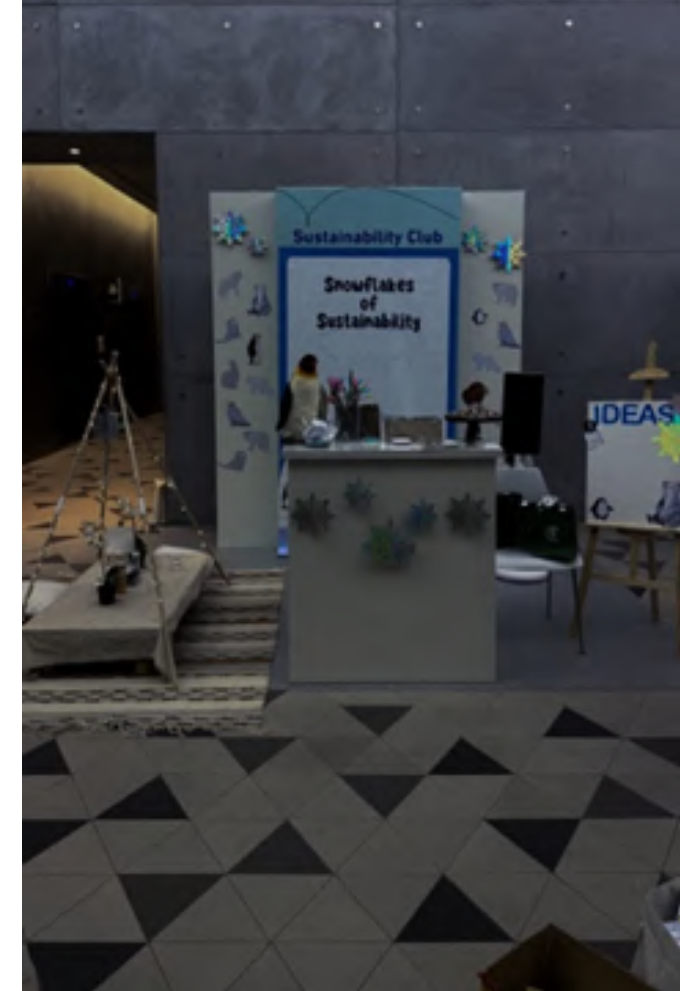


Sustainability Club Activities

KU Club Fair 2025 (Sustainability Club Booth)

The Sustainability Club organized engagement activities to introduce students to environmental awareness, promote eco-friendly habits, and encourage participation in sustainability initiatives through interactive booths and discussions.



Sustainability in the UAE: Air, Sea & Land (with IFHC)

An interactive sustainability awareness event. The event featured four themed zones (Land, Sea, Air, and IFHC) with activities such as plant decorating, ocean clean-up games, VR dive experience, eco-car races, and a scavenger hunt. IFHC participated by providing educational materials and presentations. The event aimed to inspire students and highlight UAE's sustainability achievements.

Students learned about marine conservation and environmental responsibility. Around 25 students attended, and feedback highlighted high satisfaction and enjoyment.
